

# LANE REPORTS

It's been some time since we published our first Legacy Lane Report for the Projects Lane. As a Leadership Team, we went into calendar 2020 with a grandiose plan of publishing one comprehensive Legacy Lane Report that we would update periodically and that would include navigation tools allowing you to move easily from and through each of the different Legacy Lanes. We recognize that most of the Legacy Team has one or more lanes that they are more passionate about, but we also believe that all of you want to be informed about all of the lanes and are willing to pray over the entire report. Although the pandemic is not behind us by any means, we feel like some of the fog is lifting and as such, we are in the process of revisiting our Legacy Lanes, and moving forward on the plans that were sidelined on March 16, along with so many of our plans, hopes, and dreams.

The first step toward that end is to communicate to our Legacy Team some of the initiatives that are front and center right now at our Henderson Church location. These will be rolled into the formal Legacy Report going forward, but for the short-term they will only reside here in this narrative.

- Roof Repair - We have piecemealed the roof repair project and require an additional \$50,000 to complete the repair work.
- Parking Lot Resealing - Our parking lot needs to be resealed and requires \$30,000 to complete.
- HVAC System Repairs and Upgrades - Our team has identified \$200,000 in critical repairs and upgrades required to take our HVAC systems to a place where they can adequately carry the anticipated load over the next 5-7 years.
- Truck and Trailer - Our Hope For The City and Henderson operations require the use of a truck/trailer combination to reduce rental costs related to serving our existing base of seniors and immunocompromised with food insecurities and to expand our base to serve even more.
- Warehouse - Our Hope For The City and Henderson operations team have a dream of building an ~30,000 square foot warehouse costing ~\$100,000 that would alleviate storage issues and would allow us to more efficiently serve our community through our outreach programs.
